"Many companies are mired in mazes of point-to-point application interfaces that have been incrementally added to existing systems over time simply to share information between various applications," Henning said. "It takes an enormous amount of time and effort first to create and then to maintain these interfaces – and the Avantis Integration Suite has been designed specifically to solve these problems.

"This suite is the first deliverable in our cAO initiative and we view cAO as the hub of the enterprise – transforming plant floor data into actionable business information and simultaneously taking business information and bringing it to wherever it may be needed on the plant floor."

"Although there are many ways to integrate systems, the model that is required for e-business is one that is based on business processes; it has become a strategic imperative because business processes will inevitably change over time," said John Campbell, chief executive officer of Canopy International.
