- Process Framework is the underlying engine that translates processes into functional web pages.
- Process Management Centre is a thin-client application that allows you to configure, manage, monitor and generate reports on processes.

It's people oriented. Unlike Business Process Management (BPM), which focuses on automating back-office procedures and removes people from the equation, BroadVision Process focuses squarely on people -- making the process aware of people (who needs to be engaged in the process and what they need

to accomplish during the process) and making people aware of the process (how the process works and where they are in the process).

It's agile. As more and more business activities migrate to the web, IT organisations are overwhelmed with service and support requests. By reducing development time from months and years of hard coding to days of modelling, BroadVision Process allows IT organisations to keep pace with demand while building on a unified framework that is cost-effective to maintain. Once new processes have been deployed to the web, changes are accomplished with the same ease and speed.

It's open. Many organisations are investigating Open Source as a web platform, to benefit from lower cost of ownership and performance improvements. BroadVision Process offers the option of running on a commercial J2EE platform (Solaris, HP-UX, AIX or Windows with WebLogic or WebSphere, and Oracle, SQL Server, Sybase or Informix) or on an Open Source J2EE platform such as Linux with Jboss and Hypersonic.
