

Book your Madrid Hotels whilst attending the Madrid Fashion Week

There is only a month or so to go until the Spanish capital becomes the centre of couture culture, as the biannual Madrid International Fashion Week kicks off.

Between Thursday February 12th and Saturday February 14th, the Feria de Madrid will play host to the event, which will showcase a wide variety of clothing, including autumn and winter collections for 2009-10.

Models are set to take to the catwalk to display the offerings of both up-and-coming and established designers.

Tickets are priced at €30, but cost just €15 if people pre-register.
