

# UK Nurses like to travel with their job, and then return again!

The nursing jobs web site, Nurses.co.uk - Nursing Jobs (<http://www.nurses.co.uk>), has reported that almost three-quarters of the nurses working in the UK would be prepared to move overseas in their job.
