

# ServiceNow Recognised on 2011 Inc. 500 List With Three-Year Sales Increase of 1,240 Percent

SAN DIEGO – Sept. 1, 2011 – ServiceNow, the creators of SaaS for IT (<http://www.service-now.com/>), today announced it is ranked on the 2011 Inc. 500 for the second year in a row. ServiceNow annual recurring revenue of \$62.2 million at the end of FY 2010 and three-year growth rate of 1,240 percent make it the fastest growing software company with revenues greater than \$50 million. The Inc. 500 is a ranking of the fastest-growing privately held companies in the U.S.

ServiceNow was created to fundamentally change the enterprise IT software industry for good. The 2011 Inc. 500 ranks companies by percentage revenue growth from 2007 to 2010.
