

Testinternetspeed.org Releases Details of Countries Most Concerned with Internet Speed.

Connection speeds to the internet can vary significantly between countries and service providers. If download speed is swift one day and crawls along the next, then it may indicate that something is amiss. PC performance experts Uniblue urge anyone who uses the Internet to check their connection speeds on a regular basis as an important part of computer monitoring to retain PC productivity levels. Their site, testinternetspeed.org has a free internet speed test (<http://testinternetspeed.org>) tool allowing users to check the speed of their connection. The tool checks file up- and download times, generating a report on the results. This is completed in a single mouse click without installing any additional software; it's simply a matter of transferring a small, non-executable data file from the server to the PC concerned and then back again to the server. Results are presented literally in seconds from within the tool itself.

In order to deliver a comprehensive overview of levels of interest in finding out about connection speeds by country, a sample of over 250,000 speed tests from over 200 countries was taken from the site. The results showed levels of concern split between developed and developing nations, with users from the USA putting their connections to the test more than other nationalities using the site. Users in the UK and Canada put their countries in the Top 10 as well as users from India, Malaysia, Serbia and Saudi Arabia. Analytical calculations were made primarily by using visits and internet population per country.
