

# British Hairdressing Business Awards Finalists Announced

The judges go through the same process, marking each entry individually. In some categories, salons may receive mystery client visits or calls, and one-to-one interview sessions with the finalists of Junior of the Year, Manager of the Year and Business Director of the Year will take place. The winners of all 16 categories will be announced at a glittering black tie event hosted by a leading media personality on Monday 17th September at the Lancaster London Hotel in London.

Publishing Director of Hairdressers Journal International, Jayne Lewis-Orr, concludes, "The passion and professionalism of the businesses who entered the British Hairdressing Business Awards is a credit to the hairdressing industry and everyone who has achieved finalist status can be justifiably proud."
