Designs in the Fair and Fine Botany Collection by Liz Earle include:

- Eucalyptus – a symbol of healing and protection

- Ivy – a symbol of eternity, love and friendship
- Wild Rose – a symbol of love and femininity
- Neroli – a symbol of fruitfulness, purity and grace

The collection features rings, earrings, bracelets and necklaces, including pieces which can be adapted and worn in different ways, such as 'stackable' rings, stud earrings with optional leaf or crystal drops, and necklaces with adaptable link chains. Prices start from £136.
