## Appointment of General Director to Aras Kargo by Trustee

He was both a family friend, and trusted natural advisor. He is always with Erdogan on both domestic and international trips. Bulduk, who served as General Manager of BELTUR during the period that Erdogan was the Istanbul Metropolitan Municipality Mayor, is a graduate of Istanbul University Business Administration Faculty. Having completed his masters degree in Management Organization at the same university, Hikmet Nuri Bulduk is married and speaks English.
