It's an adventure like no other, especially for youngsters, and recent research by Visit Britain shows camping is becoming a national obsession – with some 15 million trips made (that's an eighth of all excursions in the UK) and other estimates putting it at 21 million trips of this kind by 2020.

As modern life becomes increasingly more manic and stressful, camping is all about taking time out to relax, renew and rejuvenate. There's nothing better than communing with nature to put you in a better frame of mind and Trevornick embodies everything that's fun and magical about outdoor family holidays in Cornwall – and then some.

Other highlights include a heated outdoor swimming pool, golf course and pitch and putt, fishing lakes, ice cream parlour, kids club, soft play area and playground, farm shop, Surf School, sports field, nature trail and woodland, Tranquillity spa, games room and teenage hangout, laidback family eateries and lounge bar, plus with daily entertainment on site, you have all your family holiday requirements literally in one place.

This all adds up to a real outdoorsy family holiday to remember and when you and the kids work together to put up tents, cook dinners on a camping stove and eventually bed down, cocooned under canvas beneath the stars, the sense of satisfaction is hard to beat.

With electricity, gas and plenty of storage space for your outdoor gear, plus your own picnic table, camping has never been so easy and rewarding, so embrace Cornwall's saltwater lifestyle while enjoying your home comforts. Literally, all you have to bring is your bedding...

If you want the wholesome fun of camping, but also hassle-free, then Eurotents are for you. Kids love camping by the sea, full stop – and Holywell Bay is one of the UK's loveliest beaches – so when parents get on the same wavelength everyone's happy!
