

Secretary of State for Health and Social Care Matt Hancock to Give Keynote Speech at GIANT Health Event

The Secretary of State for Health and Social Care, Matt Hancock (<https://www.gov.uk/government/people/matthew-hancock>), will be giving a keynote speech on the second day of the GIANT Health event (<https://www.gianthealthevent.com/>), Thursday November 22 2018, which is staged at Chelsea Football Club, Stamford Bridge, London.

GIANT Health, set up by American-born technology entrepreneur Barry Shrier (<https://uk.linkedin.com/in/barryshrier>), who lives in Oxford, is an annual conference dedicated to the promotion of health technology that improves the outcomes of citizens globally. The event celebrates the value of the contributions to healthtech innovation from diverse people including inventors, app developers, clinicians, corporate enterprises, the investment community, healthcare service administrators and startups.

Health Secretary Matt Hancock (<https://www.gov.uk/government/people/matthew-hancock>) said, "I want the UK to become the home of HealthTech to complement our world-leading life science, artificial intelligence and genomic sectors and some of the best technology companies on the planet.

"We must embrace this coming wave of technology and transform our NHS into an ecosystem of innovation and enterprise so patients benefit from the latest treatments.

"I'm looking forward to meeting the pioneering companies at GIANT Health and identifying ways we can work together to revolutionise healthcare."

Barry Shrier, founder of GIANT added, "We feel honoured that the Health Secretary will see for himself the amazing innovation and enterprise on show, designed to deliver the best possible outcomes for society at large."

Opening both days of the conference is the Chairman of GIANT, London-based Professor Shafi Ahmed (<https://uk.linkedin.com/in/professor-shafi-ahmed-7114a260>), a cancer surgeon, global educator and visionary, plus co-founder of a virtual reality (VR) company that provides novel ways to educate students.
