The UK Jewellery Awards' winners will be announced on the 2nd July 2020 at a glitzy ceremony at The Tower of London.

This recognition comes shortly after Lebrusan Studio announced the incorporation of recycled diamonds (https://www.lebrusanstudio.com/blogs/news-releases/sustainable-jewellery-brand-lebrusan-studio-begins-incorporating-recycle across its collections; a step towards embracing as many reclaimed materials as possible in a bid to reduce environmental impact. Last year the sustainable jeweller also underwent a significant rebrand (https://www.lebrusanstudio.com/blogs/news-releases/lebrusan-studio-unveils-new-website-as-part-of-major-rebrand), involving a change in brand name and the launch of a sleek and contemporary new site.

The shortlist positions allude to another year of success and recognition for the eponymous jeweller. Last year, Arabel Lebrusan was shortlisted for Professional Jeweller's Jewellery Designer of the Year Award, not long after being appointed as an ambassador for the Women's Jewellery Network in the Ethical Retail category. The jewellery brand's recent digital and ethical developments also earned it three NAJ Award nominations at the end of 2019.
