"The platform contains a 30 question test, which every temporary worker has to pass in order to be considered ready to work. The modules within the test include general responsibilities, accident prevention and reporting, Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), safety signs and signals and some sector specific questions, covering all the main health & safety topics that Barker Ross would expect workers to be familiar with."

As well as investing in the new Worksafe package, Barker Ross is also expanding its team to service demand from the industry in the Midlands region.
